### Parking around school

Concerns have been raised about parking near to the school. Parents are parking illegally, blocking driveways and parking on double yellow lines during drop off and pick up times. ### School photographer

Our photographer will be in school from 7.45am on Thursday to take individual photographs of our children. If you wish to have a family portrait, please call to the junior hall between 7.45am and 9am. Please ensure your child is in full school uniform.

### School Dinners

Please be reminded that school dinners need to be **ordered and paid for in advance**. We have found the Direct Debit option is the easiest way to pay for the school dinners. You will receive a statement with the amount due along with the payment date. This is usually around 2 weeks after the statement date. There have been occasions where children have arrived at the serving hatch and their meal has not been ordered or paid for. This has caused upset for the child and a delay in arranging their meal.

### Wet mornings

I am writing to inform you of the children's entry to school on 'Wet mornings' for the children in the infants.

1. In the event of bad weather, at 8.50am, the school bell will ring twice.
2. Upon hearing the bell, children are invited into the Infant Hall.
3. A member of staff will greet the children and parents are asked to leave their child under the supervision of our staff.
4. After 9.00am parents should take their child into school through the Infant office.
