Dear Parents/Guardians,

As a school, we are very keen to emphasise the importance of reading. This is both **children reading stories** and also **children listening to stories**.

I would like to start a new reading initiative with children from Nursery to Year 2 called 'Snuggle Up Books'. These will be books that will be sent out every Friday for an **adult to read to their child**. It will need to be carried out in a quiet, cosy area, for example, in bed, so that both the child and adult can 'snuggle up' and enjoy a story together.

In order to get this initiative underway, we are looking to create a separate library of books within each classroom which will be called 'Snuggle Up Books'. Initially we will only need 30 books in each class and then will be able to rotate them each week. A sticker will be placed in any donated books in recognition of your generosity. Please give any books direct to your child's class teacher so we are aware of who has kindly donated.
