Dear Parent / Guardian,

On return to school it has come to my attention that some children are not adhering to the school uniform policy.

Can I remind parents:

Hair

- Hair should have no “tramlines” or designs of any description shaved into children’s hair. There should be no “Mohican” style haircuts.
- Big bows or beads in the hair are not allowed.
- Long hair needs to be tied back.

Uniform

- Children can wear cardigans providing they are in line with the school colour.
- Any sweatshirts need to have the school logo.
- Tights should be plain grey, navy or black. No patterns, stripes or spots.
- Socks should be plain grey, navy or black. No patterns, stripes or spots.

Footwear

- Children should wear sensible shoes, no ankle or full length boots are permitted. In Winter, children can come to school in boots to ensure they are warm and dry. When at school they will need to change into their sensible school shoes.

Can I remind parents that the home / school agreement states that parents support the school in all matters of policy.
